

Dear Friends,

On behalf of the Rusty Johnson's American Dreams Committee, I'd like to ask for your help to make brighter futures for foster kids. First, I'd like to share some statistics showing why your help is desperately needed.

- Only about 50% of foster children graduate from high school.
- Less than 5% will graduate from a four-year college.
- Only 2-6% receive a two-year degree.
- 90% will experience significant trauma.
- Half of this population is 250% more likely to develop mental disorders.
- 20% are instantly homeless, and 40% will be homeless within 18 months of turning 18 years old.

I was one of the over 400,000 kids dropped into this bowl of statistics, but I beat the odds ...with the help of a "village."

The summer before my 4th-grade year, I was placed in foster care, and would cycle between 20 different foster homes, residential homes, temporary placements, and even institutions. One of the things that helped me defy the statistics was my saxophone. My biological mother gave me a saxophone during a supervised visit, and at the same time, I was living with a foster mother who was also my elementary music teacher. After my biological mother's suicide, I took to the saxophone, practicing harder and harder every day. Because of my dedication to music, I received positive reinforcement, learned dedication and work ethic, and understood what it was to have achievable goals and dreams. Now, I want to give other foster kids the same opportunity that was given to me.

On October 19th, 2024, I will host my fifth national Rusty Johnson's American Dreams at Central College in Pella, Iowa. To accomplish this, we desperately need your help! Funds will be donated to Four Oaks Family & Children Services, who in return will use these funds to sponsor Iowa's at-risk kids to receive music and dance lessons, attend sports and drama camps—whatever it is that's above and beyond what foster parents can afford but will help nourish Iowa's kids' dreams. With your help, this is possible!

"If you build it, they will come" is a famous quote from "Field of Dreams," an Iowa movie classic. I'm doing my best to build "it"! # Rusty Johnson's American Dreams in a snapshot

- The Media Tour-
  - Approximately one-two month's prior to Saturday, October 19, advertisements will be released promoting the upcoming Rusty Johnson's American Dreams. In addition to promoting the event to ensure ticket sales for the evening show, strategic points will be inserted for state-wide educational purposes.
  - Approximately two week prior to Rusty Johnson's American Dreams, Rusty Johnson, Four Oaks representation (the beneficiary), committee members, guest musicians and others will embark on a educational media tour consisting on interviews on radio, TV, newspapers and other outlets to raise awareness of specific and current needs pertaining to at-risk youth/ foster care in Iowa.
- The Conference-
  - Four Oaks and the Rusty Johnson American Dreams Committee will coordinate a conference on the campus of Central College Saturday, October 19. The conference will address the current topics within child welfare and Iowa and will be intended to educate Iowa's child welfare professionals, staff, foster parents, school personnel and communities.
- · Iowa's Current & Former Foster Youth Empowerment-
  - Iowa's current and former foster youth are invited to be on campus the day and evening of October 19 for Rusty Johnson's American Dreams. With the assistance of Central College, current/former foster youth are able to learn about Central, higher education and tour the college. Past Rusty Johnson American Dreams have hosted foster youth/alumni empowerment group mini conferences and with full potential to do so again October 19.
- VIP Pre-Show Reception-
  - Approximately one-hour prior to the Rusty Johnson's American Dreams Show, Sponsors and Partners are invited to attend a pre-show meet and greet reception. In addition to the Sponsors and Partners, featured artists, community leaders and current/former foster youth leaders will have the opportunity to fellowship.
- The Show-
  - Rusty Johnson's American Dreams Show will be held on October 19, in Douwstra Auditorium on the campus of Central College, in Pella, Iowa. Rusty Johnson will join musicians, such as Broadway star and big screen actress, Liz Mikel. The show is filled with inspirational and uplifting music. In addition to a current Iowa foster youth talent highlighted during the show, awards will be presented to Iowa businesses/individuals who have shown exceptional support to Iowa's at-risk youth. The show program will highlight Sponsors and Partners, in addition to inspirational stories, foster youth features and Iowa children eligible for adoption from the foster care system.

With the generous help from Sponsors and Partners, all ticket sales for the evening show, in addition to funds in excess of conference and show expenses will be donated to Iowa's at-risk youth via the beneficiary, Four Oaks.
